A name change can only be processed when the Texas Secretary of State can verify that a name change has occurred. If the corporate charter number or certificate of authority registration number issued by the Secretary of State has changed, this is considered a change in ownership. Changing from one entity to another is considered a change of ownership, requiring the permit/registration to be transferred. If the name change is due to a change in ownership, a transfer application form will need to be used to apply for a transfer of ownership.
